Adding a Div Element To Place an Item

A "div" is a handy way to quickly add a picture, animation, form or any other item on one of your pages. Once added you can move the item around on the page easily. The advantage of using a "div" is that you can "layer" the item you are adding over any other page element except for the Flash animation

Welcome Message Add-on

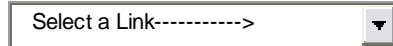
With this add-on (shown at right) you can add a .wmv, .wma, wav, mp3, mpeg, mpg or mov audio/video intro to any website or Allwebco template.

Example:



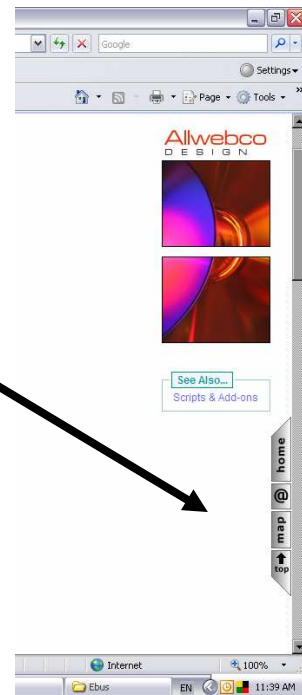

Try scrolling down on this page or making your browser small in height and use your scrollbar to see the menu float. This menu works well on pages with lots of text. If you do not see this menu your browser may not support this floating menu.
